

Study Overview


▶ Study Purpose

Recommend a program of improvement projects that will enhance safety and travel on the US 191 corridor

- ❑ Include near term (0-5 years) and longer term action items (6-20 years)
- ❑ Prepare preliminary project scoping documents to assist ADOT Northeast District in securing funding for improvements

- ▶ Complete Stakeholder Interviews (May 2017)
- ▶ Compile Study Survey Results (May 2017)
- ▶ Finalize List of Identified Issues (May 2017)
